1. What are the symptoms? Inappropriate urination, straining or frequent visits to the litter box, blood in urine, incontinence (not being able to hold urine)?
2. How long has this been going on?
3. What is the amount, frequency and type of food you are feeding your animal? Is the food canned or dry?
4. What type of litter box are you using? What kind of litter? Is it pellet or clay with deodorizer or without? Does it clump?
5. What is the drinking water source for your animal?
6. Is there any history? Blockages, stones or crystals in the urine, infections, surgeries?

A typical data base workup will include a physical exam, urine analysis, blood work and possibly X-rays. There is the possibility of sub-q fluids, cystocentesis, medications and recommended diet change. The doctor will determine the extent of the diagnostics needed based on your animal's history and clinical signs.
